



Citizens Bank has long financed private prison and detention facility companies even though there have been years of allegations of forced labor, healthcare neglect, and other abuses. Citizens is a lender to companies like CoreCivic and GEO Group, which have caused widespread, documented harm to people in their facilities.

Here in Pennsylvania, GEO operates the Moshannon Valley Processing Center, the largest ICE detention facility in the Northeast. It is where most of our neighbors are taken after ICE abducts them off the street.

Join us and ask Citizens Bank to STOP funding GEO Group and Core Civic and their abuses of the people in their facilities.

Directions to Change Bank Accounts

- Choose a new bank. Research locations, minimum deposit and personal identification needed to open an account.
- Open an account at the new bank.
- Make a list of automatic payments and deposits currently attached to your Citizens Bank account.
 - Change any direct deposits to the new bank by completing paperwork from the source(s) of the direct deposits.
 - Find out date(s) of first direct deposits will be received in the new bank.
 - Make arrangements for automatic debits and withdrawals to be made from your new account starting after the date direct deposits will be in the new bank.
- Leave enough money at Citizens Bank to cover:
 - any checks not cleared
 - automatic payments that will need to come from the account
 - avoid dropping below minimum balance required by Citizens Bank.
- After all checks and automatic payments have cleared transfer remaining money from Citizens Bank to your new account. This can be done by writing a check, transferring the money electronically, or using a cashier's check.
- Close the Citizens Bank account and ask for written confirmation when the account is closed.
